# Elementary FP7 and EURATOM statistics,

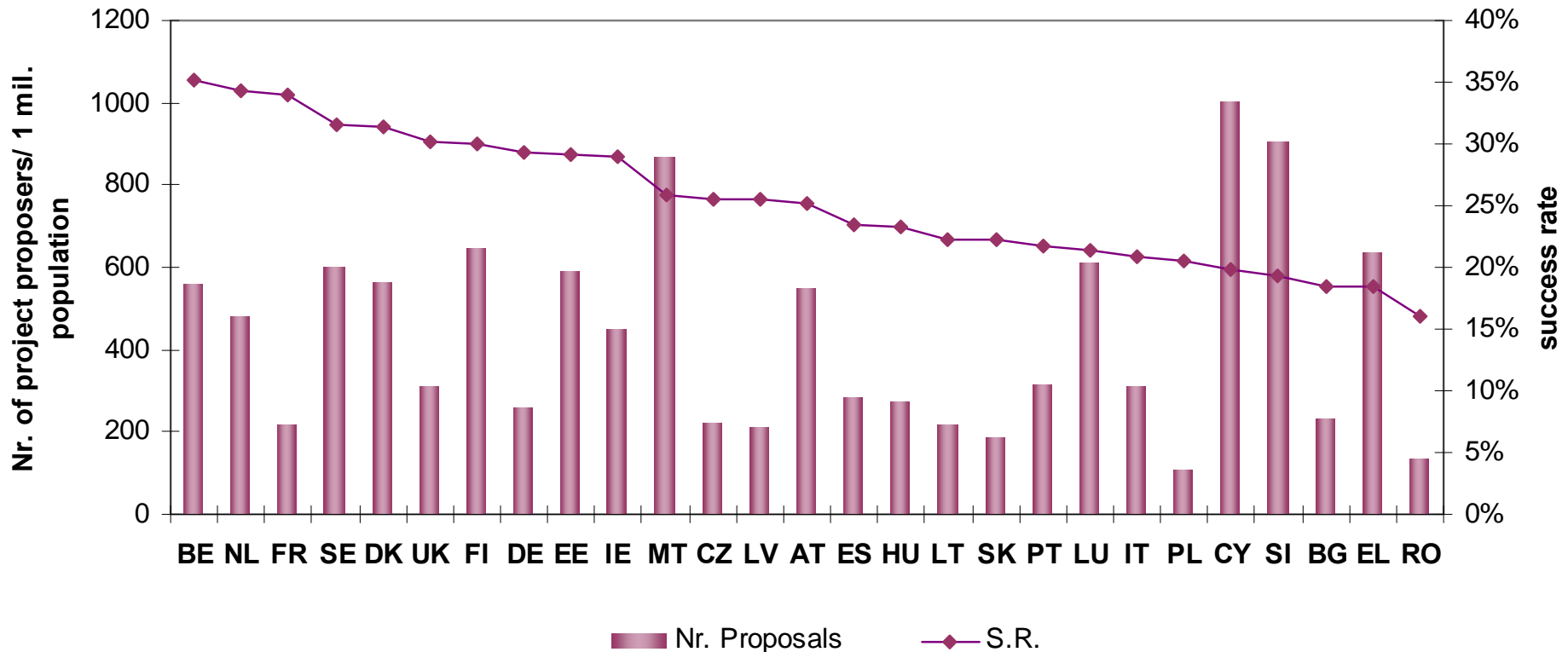
- FP7: 105 calls for proposals, reaction: **37 698** proposals compiled by **187 532** teams (E-CORDA, February 2009)
- Success rates vary according to countries (Europe: NW highest, SE smallest) and priority and...
- Statistics of participation in signed projects: EC Database E-Corda – June 2009
- **Total: 21 497** participations in **3 551** projects with the total budget M€**9 016**.
- Total EC support amounts to M€**6 652**, corresponding to 12 % of the FP7 plus EURATOM budget

# Basic FP7 CZ statistics

- 2 327 CZ teams participated in project preparation
- Main list: 375 projects with 439 CZ teams
- Signed project (so far): 225 projects with 285 CZ participants (1,6% of all participants)
- Total budget of CZ teams: 69,7 M€
- Total requested support: 51,1 M€

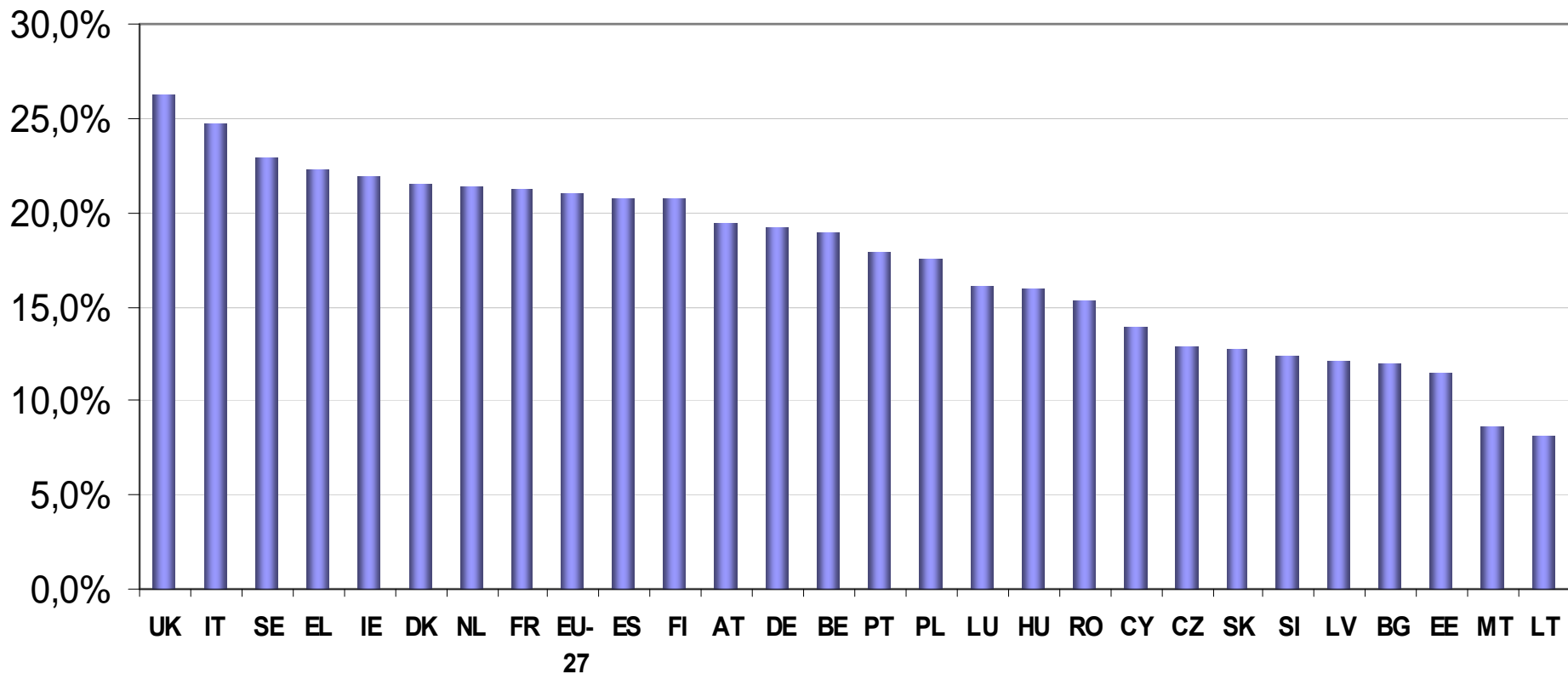

## „Country intensity of projet proposals preparation and the country paticipant success rate“



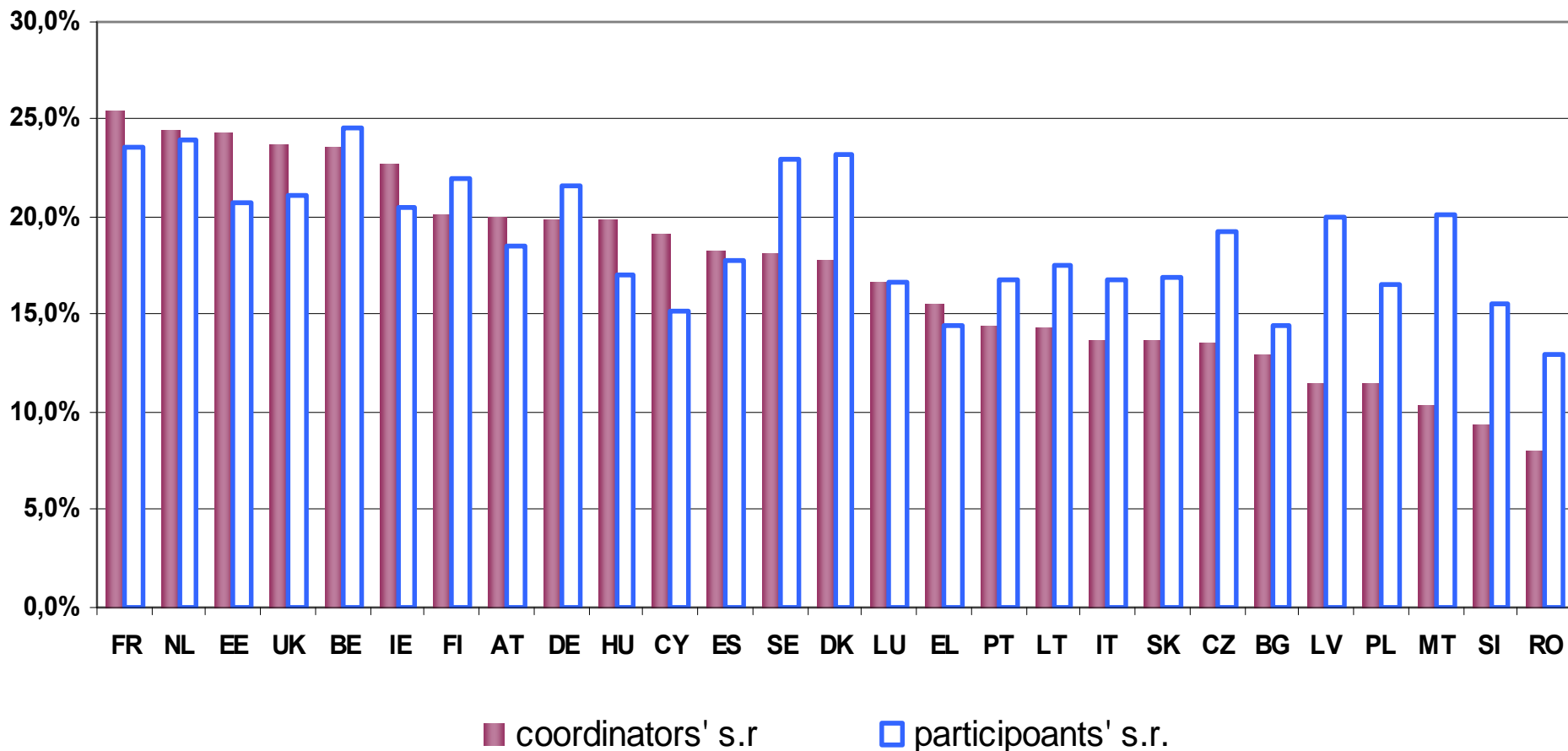

„Ratio of coordinators among all country applicants“



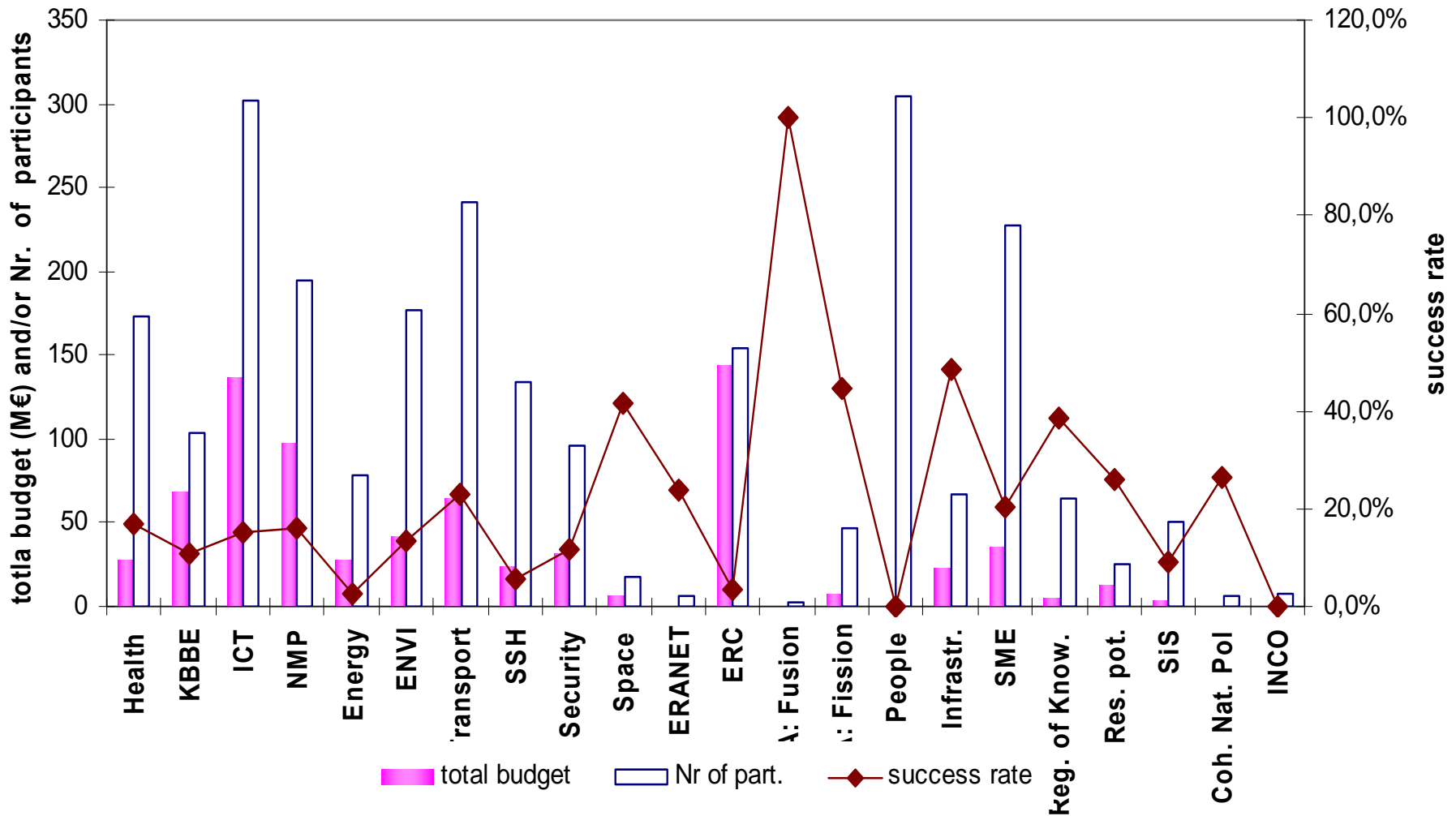

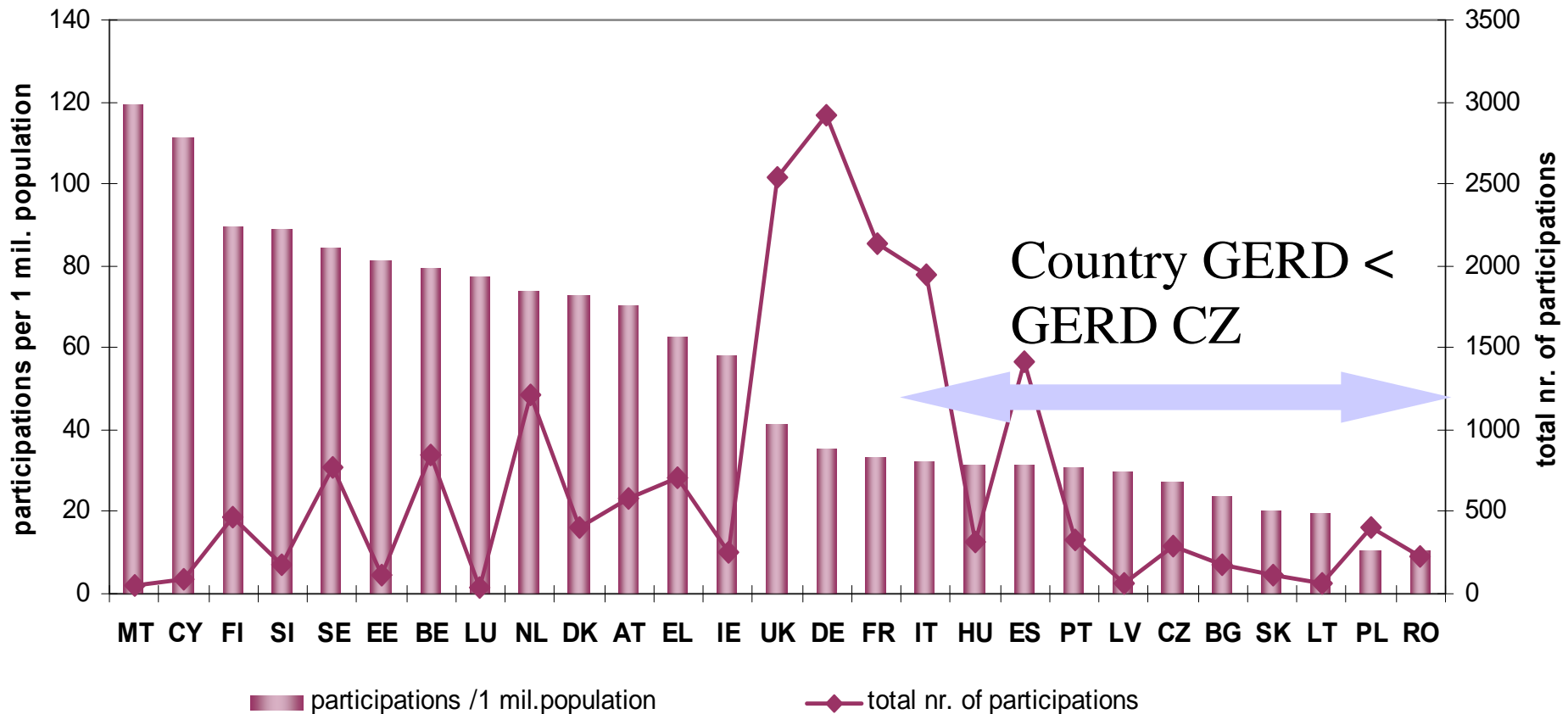
Total budget, number of participations and participant success rate

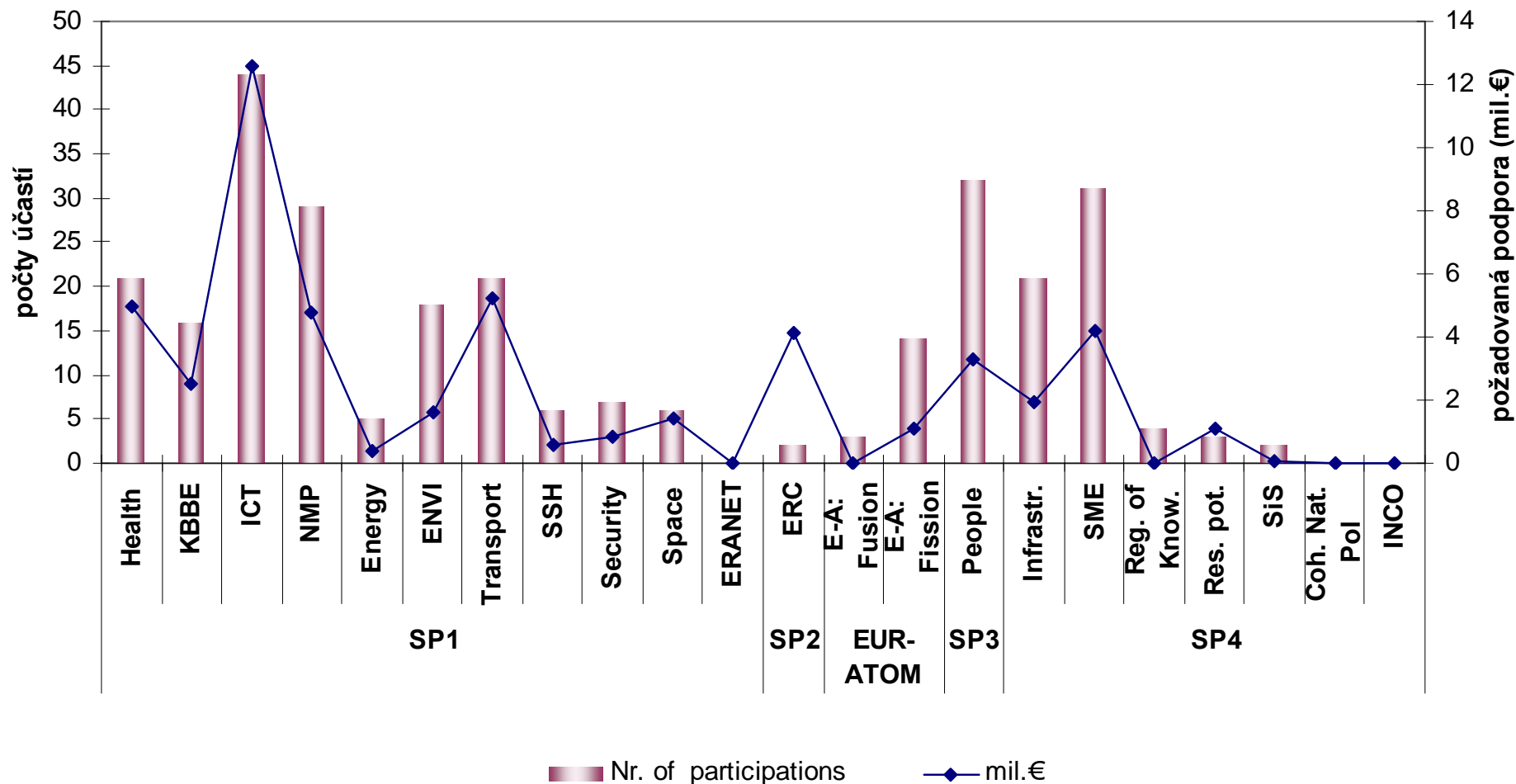

## Vision of the FP6 by absolute and relative Nr. of participations



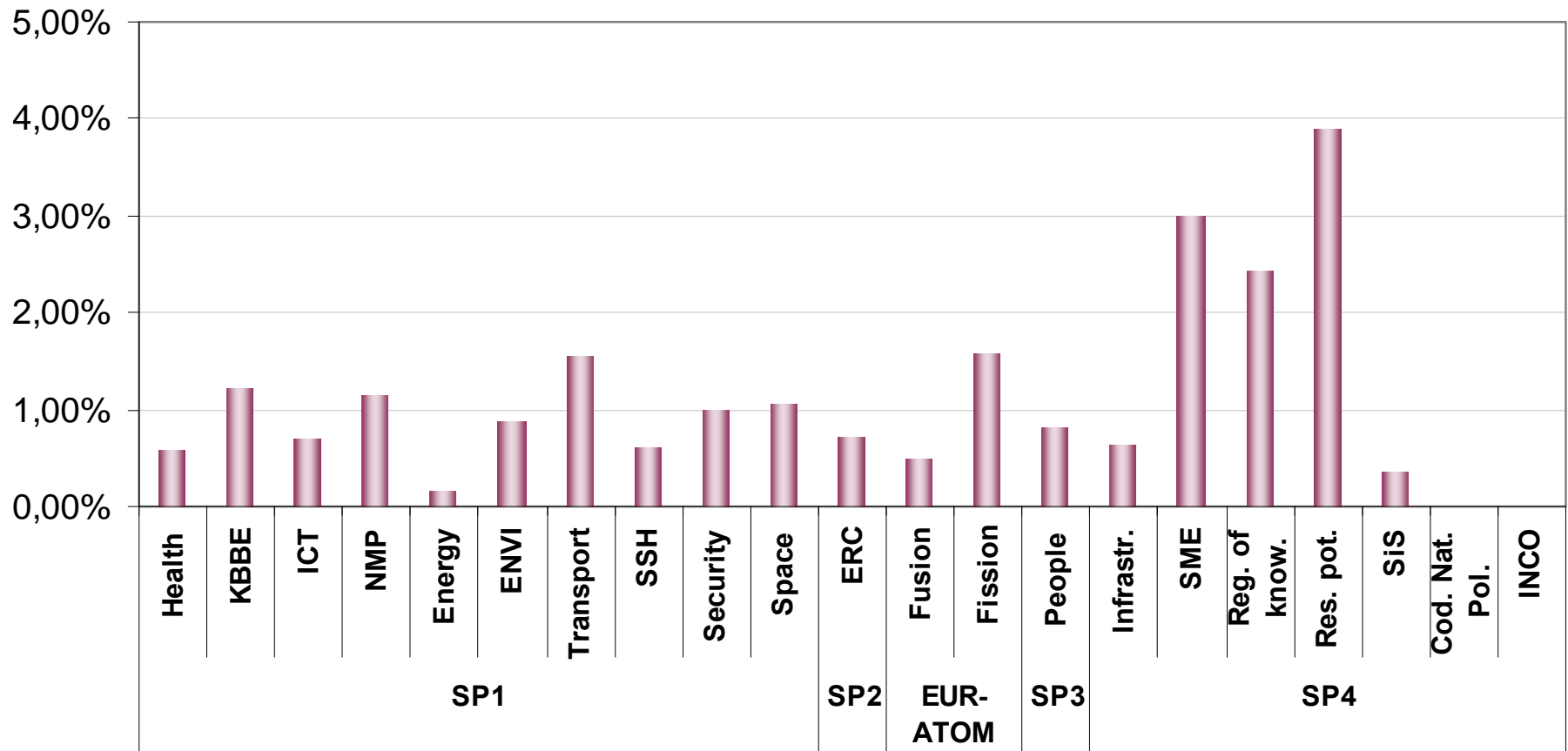

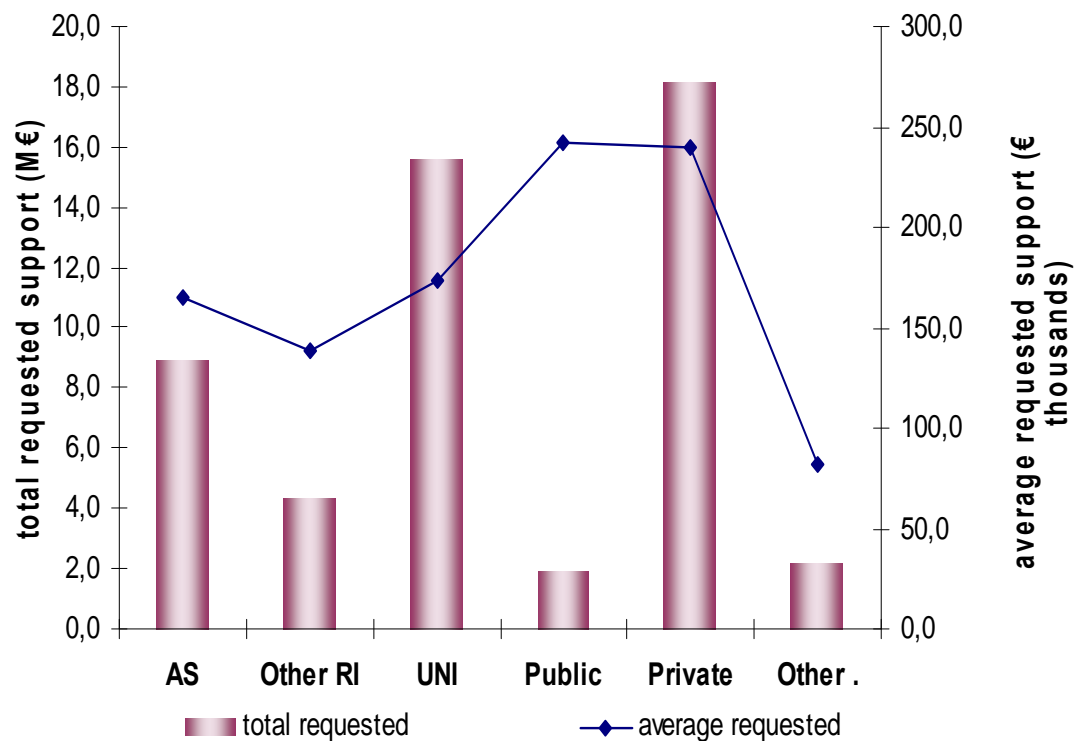
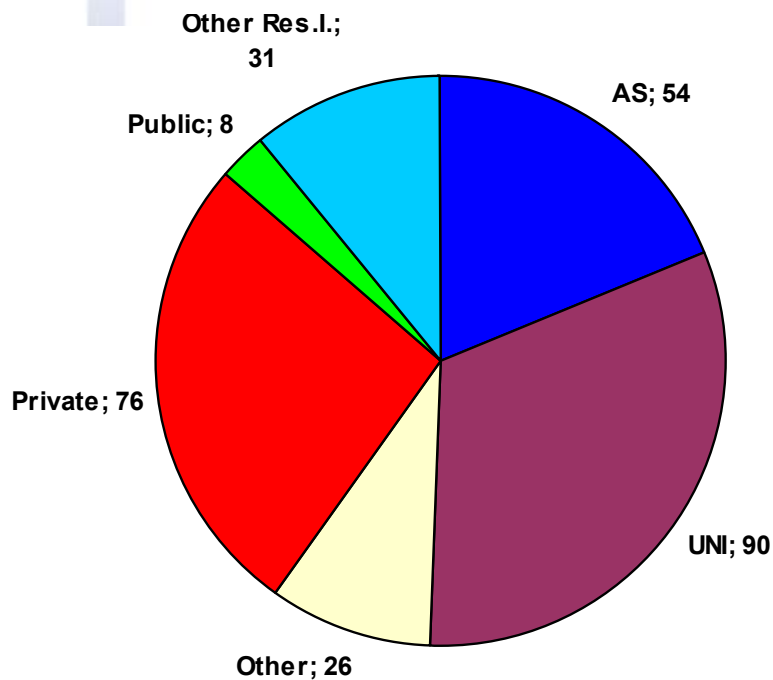


# Effectiveness of CZ participation in FP7 priorities

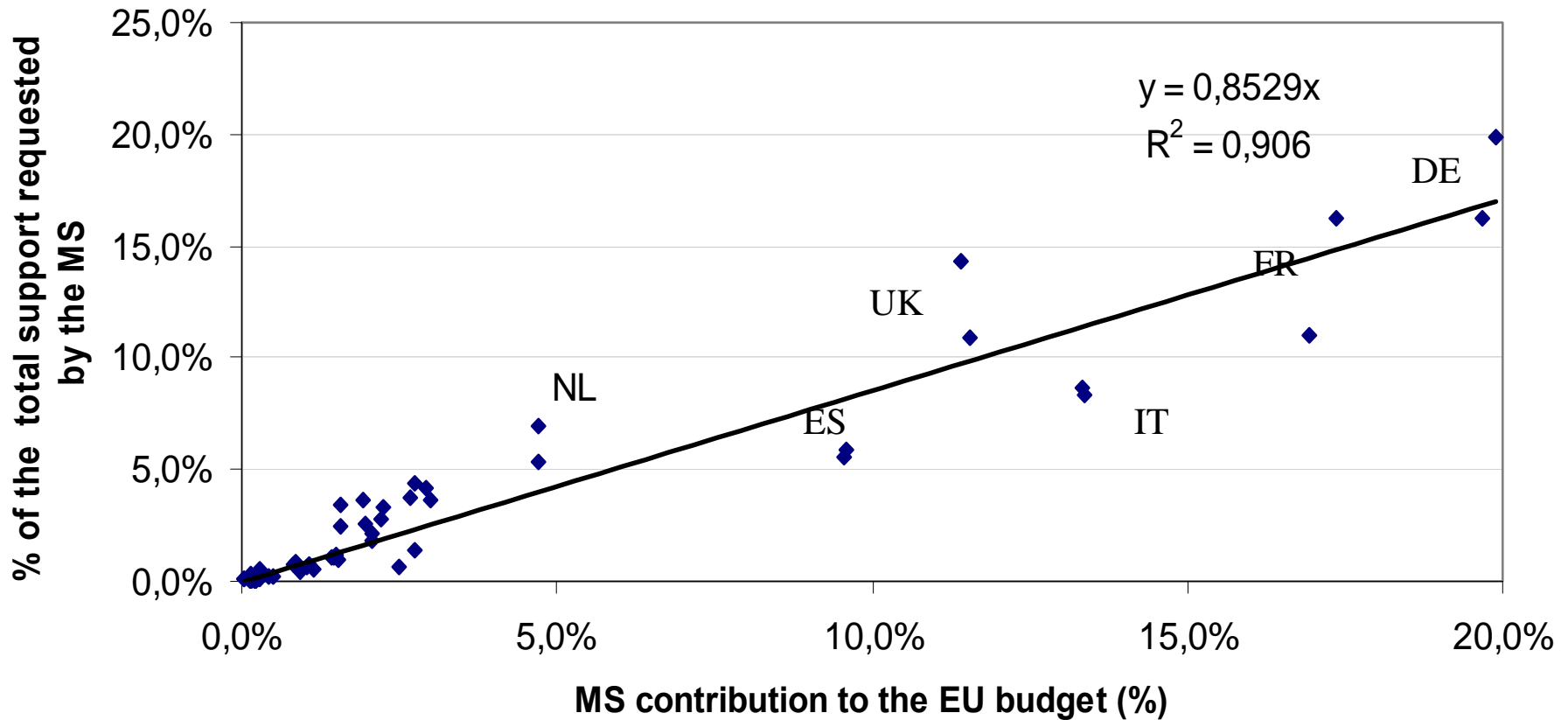
support requested by CZ teams as % of total



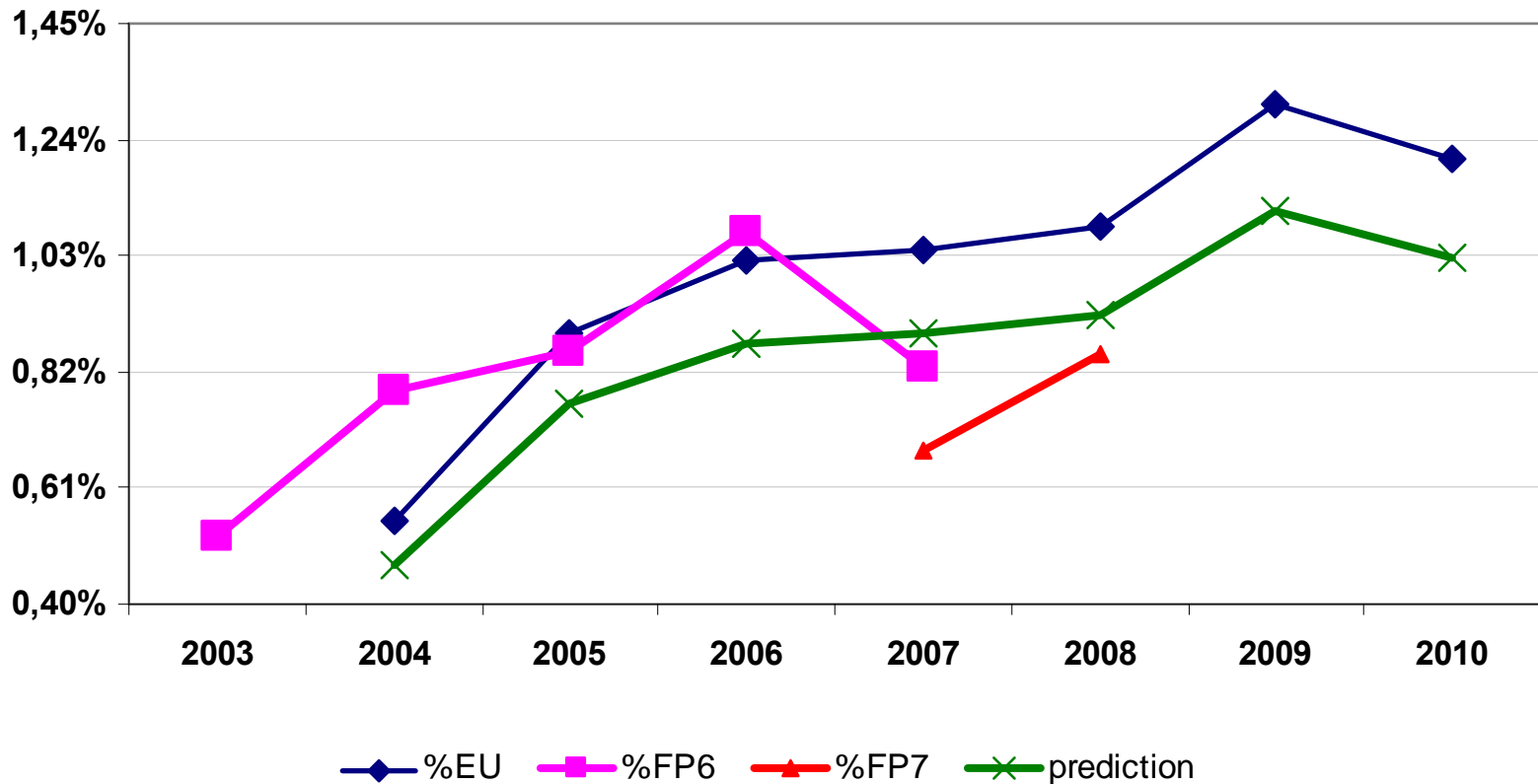
# Structure and characteristics of the CZ participation



# FP7 (FP6,FP5) property: „what you pay in(%) is what you get out (%)”

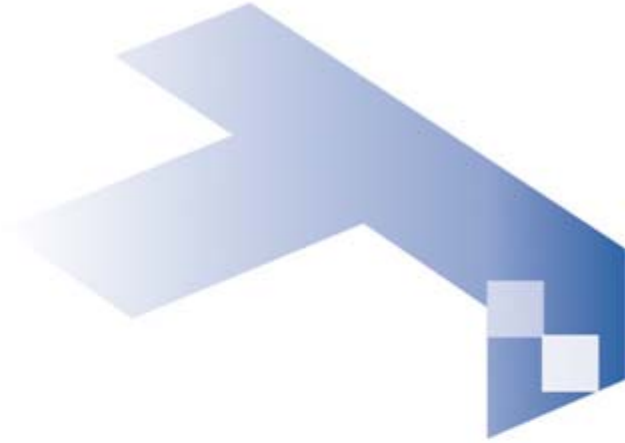


# CZ in FP7: a passive donor of the European research ?



# Some conclusions

- Success rates: quite good
- Low number of coordinators, moreover quality of CZ coordinators is doubted ( because they decrease the CZ success rate)
- Due to preparing only low number of project proposals CZ is ranked 22st position among EU-27 MS (participations/1 mil. population)
- Insufficient participation in priorities with bigger budgets
- Since FP7: the CR requests lower support than what corresponds to its contribution to the EU budget
