b) Support uptake of EU ICT research results in developing economies

- Facilitate diffusion and local exploitation of ICT research results
- Testing of solutions adapted to local requirements, e.g.
- ICT for public services (e.g. e-government, e-health, ...)
- Business-related applications (e.g. e-commerce, m-banking)
- Solutions supporting sustainable development objectives, notably for the environment
- Networking of relevant technology developers with local users

Target countries/regions:

- ACP and Mediterranean Partner Countries; other Developing Countries

- 2) Industrialised Countries, in particular but not exclusive to USA, Canada, Japan, Australia, New Zealand, Korea, Singapore; 1M€
